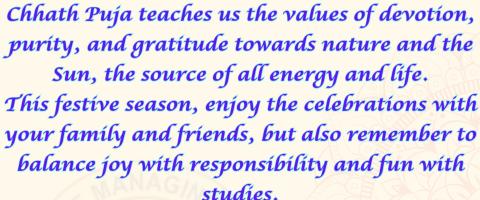


Dear Children,




